

Level 7 (QCF)

Diploma in Commissioning Procurement and Contracting for Care Services

The aim of this qualification is to guide and assess development of knowledge and skills relating to Commissioning, Procurement and Contracting, and to confirm competence in these areas where appropriate. Learners who will undertake the Level 7 Diploma in Commissioning, Procurement and Contracting for Care Services will wholly or partly be engaged in roles in social care and children's & young people's sectors in England, Wales and N Ireland. The role may or may not be specified in the job title, and it may encompass joint commissioning with health bodies.

Typical units:

- Establish commissioning practices that promote social inclusion, social cohesion and regeneration
- Position the commissioning organisation to embrace change
- Understand the process and experience of dementia
- Manage continuous improvement in organisational activities
- Secure financial resources for commissioning plan
- Understand physical disability
- Understand the needs of children and young people who are vulnerable and experiencing poverty and disadvantage

Assessment

A range of assessment methodologies will be agreed to meet learner and organisational preferences and requirements to effectively and efficiently meet the learning outcomes of the qualification.
